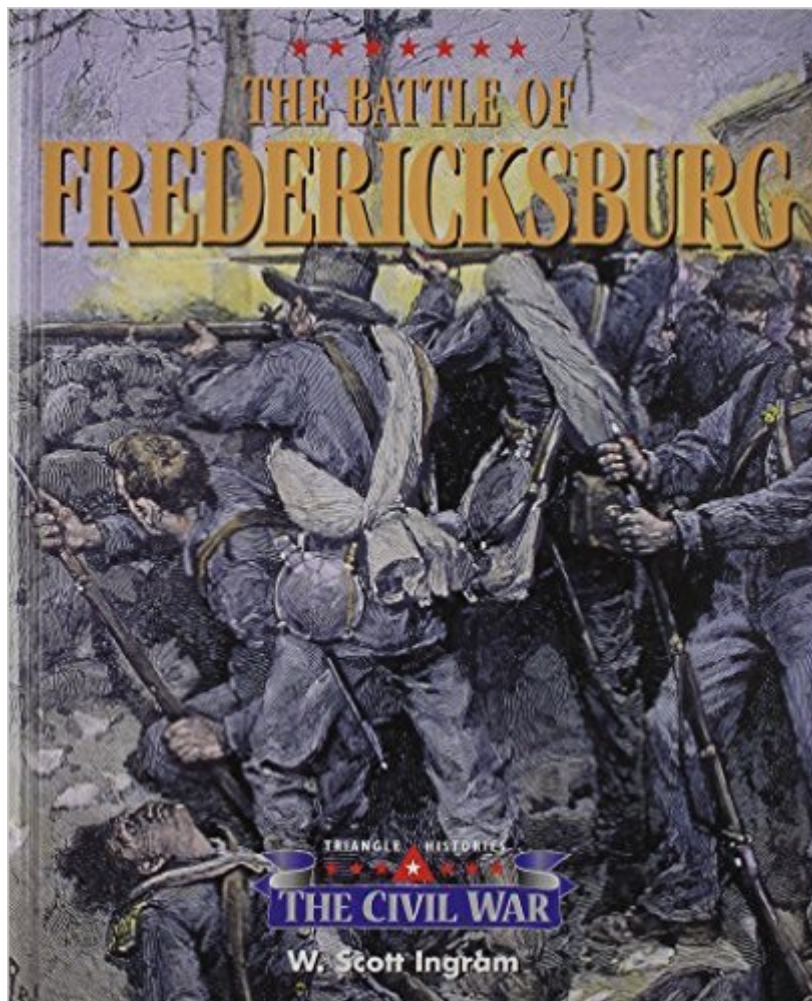


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# The Triangle Histories Of The Civil War: Battles - Battle Of Fredericksburg
