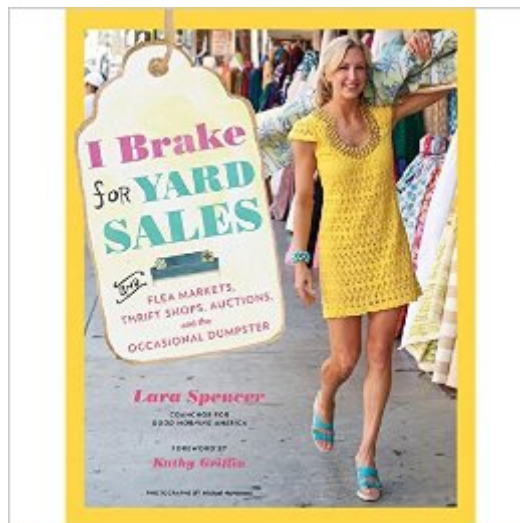


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I Brake For Yard Sales: And Flea Markets, Thrift Shops, Auctions, And The Occasional Dumpster
