Overall, this work is meant to provide a short but detailed history of the battle and serve as a traveling field aid for both the casual and serious visitor to the site. Stories of the farmsteads and the chronology of troop movements in key locations are highlights. Different perspectives of the varying terrain around the Cornfield, Bloody Lane, and Burnside Bridge are all included.
